Vendors are required to be on-site for set up at 9:30am and stay at the event until 5pm; vendors are required to clean up their assigned space at the conclusion of the event. All vendors must live in the Key Peninsula or Gig Harbor area. Only one vendor allowed per booth.

**Artists & Crafters** are persons who craft with their own hands the products they offer for sale. To qualify as a crafter, a majority of the tools and equipment used by the crafter to produce their products must require skills, personal handling and/or guidance by the crafter. No second hand items or resale allowed. No firearm or weapon sales.

**Farmers** are persons who raise the produce, plants or animals that they sell on land they own or lease/rent. It may include someone who processes produce grown on their own property into a value added product such as jams, cider, salsa, or wine. It may also include farmers who raise the basic ingredient(s) of a product, but who must send it out for processing before creating the value added product, such as smoked seafood. No homemade food items for sale or sample without an individual food permit from the Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department.

\* Each leg of your booth must be secured with 24 pounds of suspended weight, to prevent flyaway. Stakes are not adequate.
